Evaluating my app

At the beginning of this project I set out to create a prototype of a mobile app for pupils at Kelmscott School. For the mobile app I made I have 13 user requirements which I am now going to explain how I met them.

In my user requirements I wrote that I should have the Kelmscott logo which I have put on my home screen next to the Kelmscott slogan. I added the logo to represent the Kelmscott School and to show the app is associated to the school. The logo is also the brand of the school so people can recognise it, when they search for the app.

Another user requirement is to have bright/attractive colours such as navy blue and white, I used navy blue for some of my text, and I used the colour white for the buttons that take you to pages linked to the button. I also have the colour blue as my background to make it look bright and attractive. I have used these colours as these are the main colours of our school and the uniform so it resembles Kelmscott School.

Another user requirement is to have lots of pictures and writing to make my app look welcoming and easy to use for both auditory and visual users. Nearly all my screens have pictures and writing, there are only two of my screens which don't have pictures. You can see this in my PowerPoint for the development of my app. I have used pictures such as the dress code of the school so people know how the uniform looks. I also used pictures of inspirational quotes.

Another user requirement is to have links to websites that will help the pupils with their homework. In my app I added internal and external links that would take pupils to the website they want to go to. I added 8 links to websites such as Gcsepod, Bitesize ks3, Kerboodle, Gcse Bitesize, Mangahigh, Accelerated reading and Collins online learning. Pupils can use the sites on the go as the links are available 24/7 giving

and email this will make it easier for people to contact the school. I have also added the internal and external links to website so pupils can see the achievements that the school has made, also the facilities that are available.

I have added the school dress code to my app so pupils know what they are expected to wear as part of the uniform policy of Kelmscott School.
