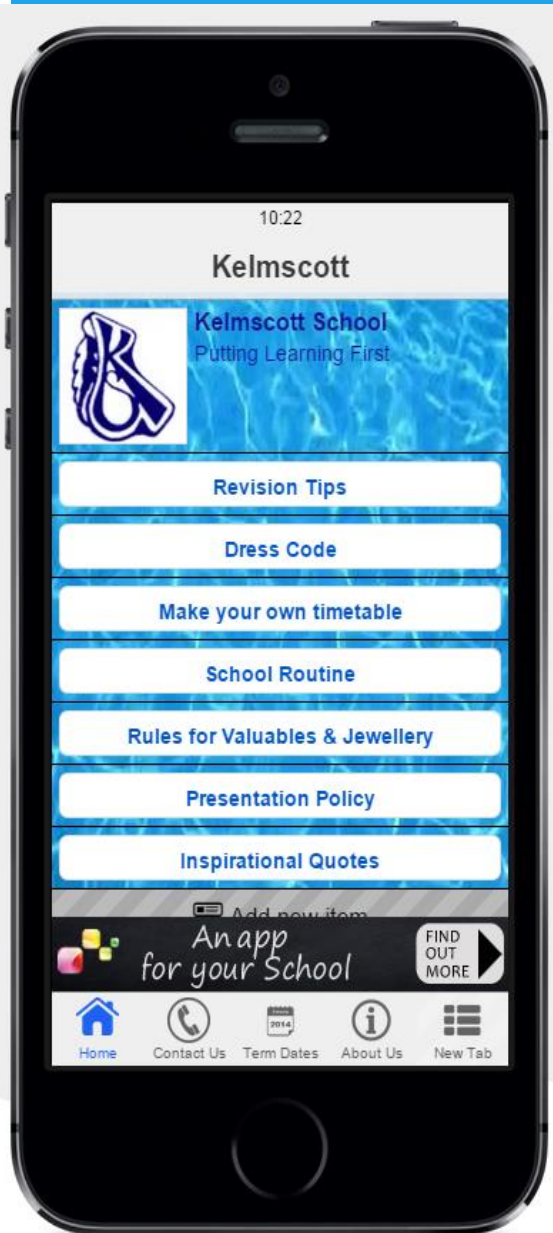


# Development of my app screens

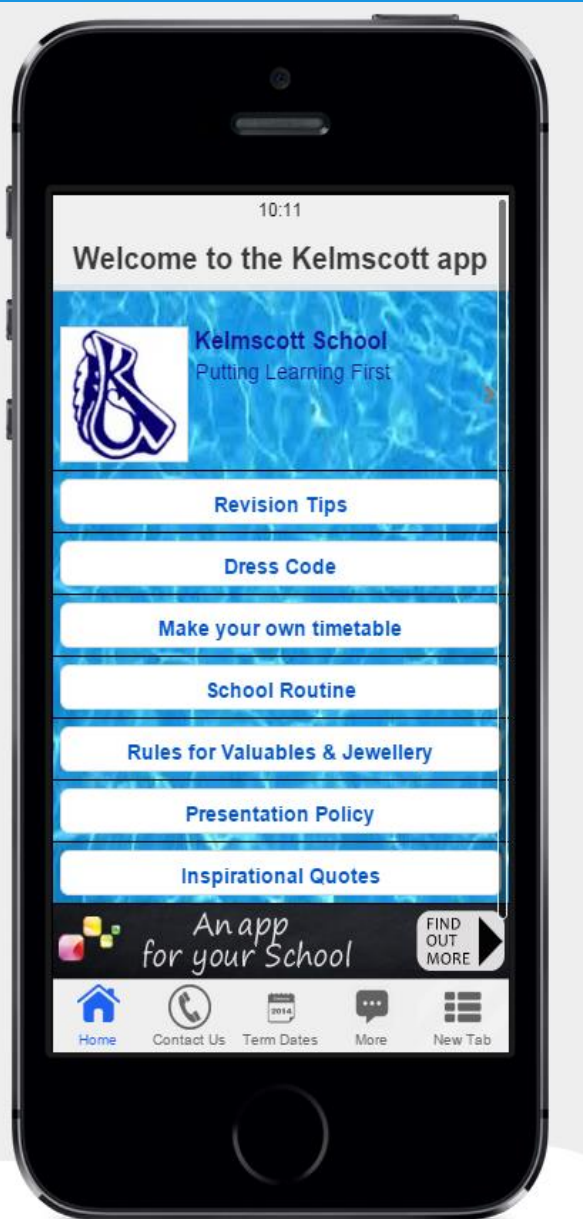

# Home Screen

# Revision Tips

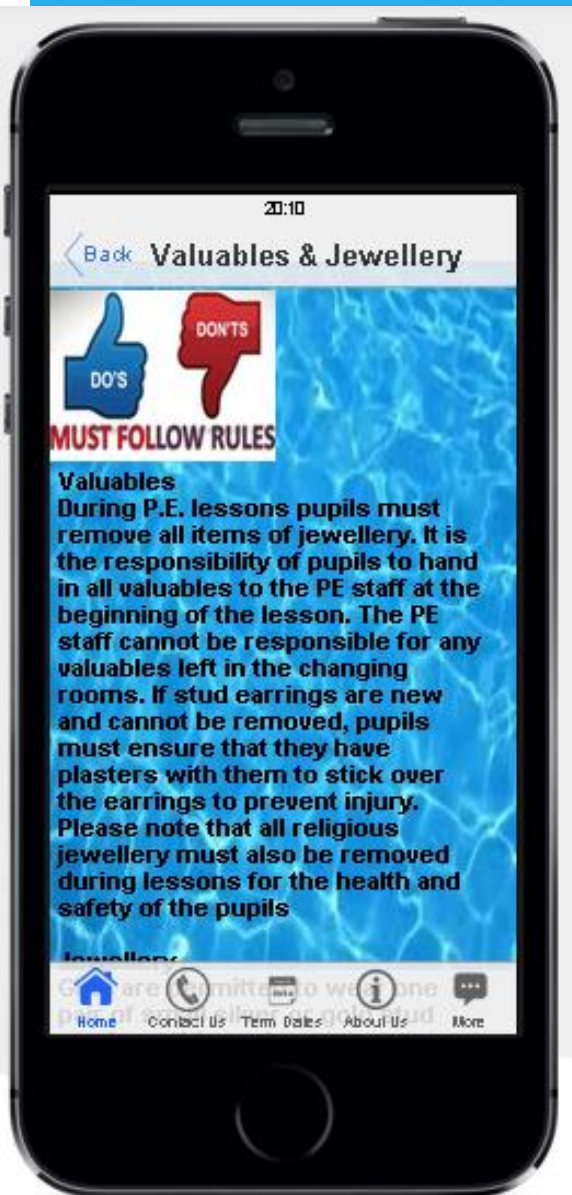


# School Routine

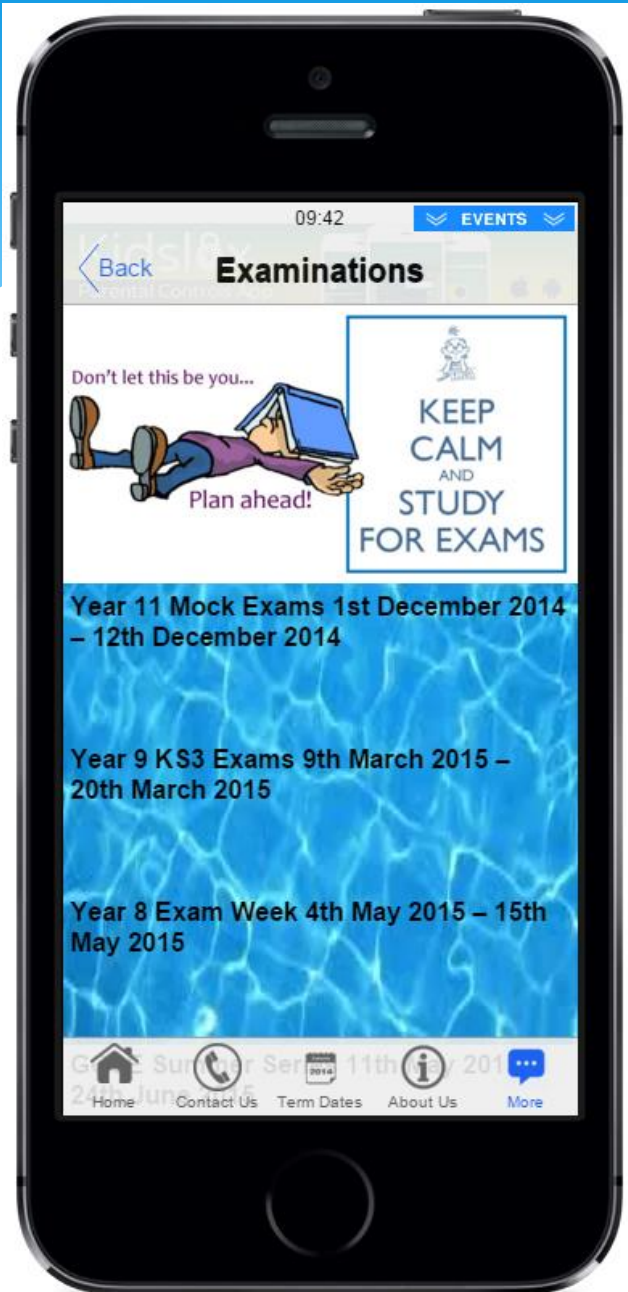
# About Us

# Examinations



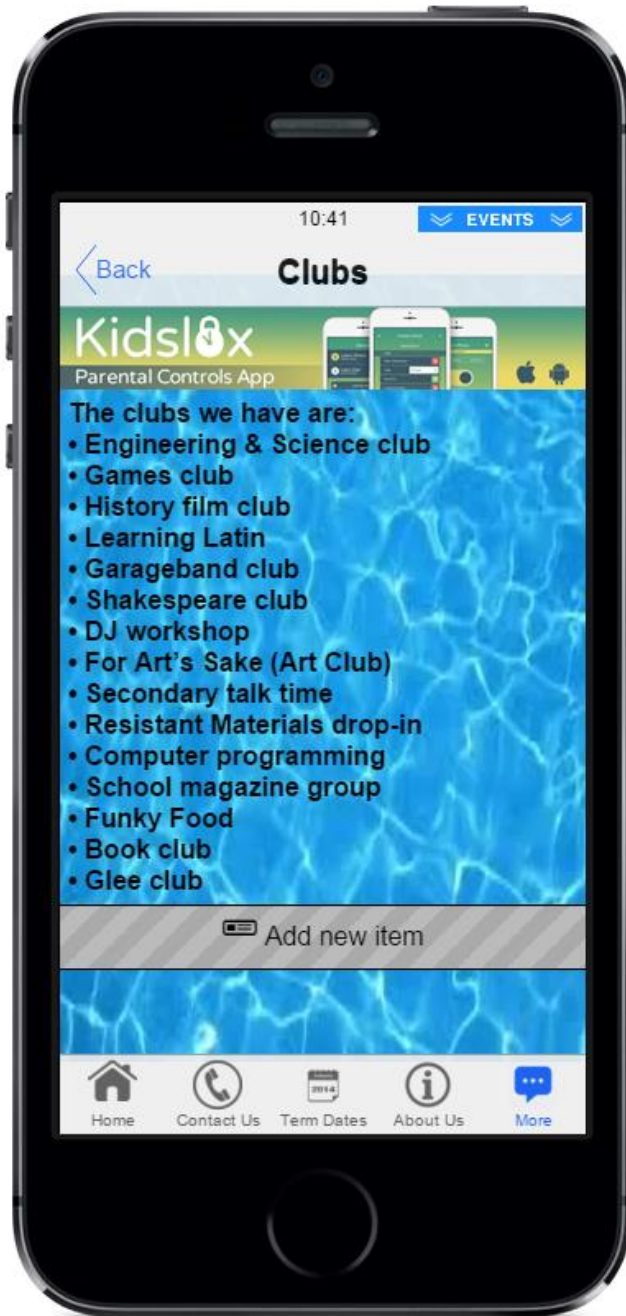
This informs the students when there exams are and that they should start studying. This means they can start preparing for their exams.
